Psalm 82, Philippians 2:5-11

A few good men...

1) The setting and message of Psalm 82

- **The setting**: a heavenly court with God as judge and 'gods' on trial (v1, 8)
- **The charges**: partiality to the wicked, neglect of the weak (v2-4)
- The verdict and judgment: guilty and sentenced to death (v5-7)

2) The identity of the 'gods' in Psalm 82

3) The application of Psalm 82

- God judges the 'judges'; therefore...
 - \Rightarrow warning for those in authority
 - \Rightarrow comfort for those under authority
- God 'judges' His anointed judge, Jesus; therefore...
 - \Rightarrow comfort for all who submit to His authority
 - \Rightarrow warning for all who reject His authority

God's way of justice in this world: brings judgement for our sins, upon His appointed Son, Jesus, only for Him to then judge the earth
