Prayer notes for Kingdom Growth Night, but also for the rest of the month.

# 1) Praying for the world and God's global church

- Thank God for His continued care over all His people across the world, especially those who belong to churches where they are persecuted for their faith, or else, caught up in war and famine. Pray that God may mercifully provide for them, protect them and give them the courage to stand firm in their faith. Pray specifically for the i) Christians in Tigray, within Ethiopia, where up to 5 million people face the prospect of starvation because of war and famine, ii) the drought in Uganda affecting many churches, and iii) the threat of the Islamist government in Northern Mozambique, where Christians face either forced conversions or death. Thank God for the aid that has reached believers in Zimbabwe's hunger-affected Matabeleland
- Pray for the current season leading up to Good Friday and Easter. Pray that across the world, God
  may use this time to draw those who've had family or person experience with Christianity, to
  return to Christ. Pray God's Spirit will stir their hearts to faith and repentance. Pray particular for
  us here at HTD and St John's, that we may make use of opportunities to share the Gospel, and to
  strengthen the faith of those who are weak and doubting.
- Pray for the church in the affluent West, to flee the temptations of their society, and instead, to stand firm in the Gospel, and be willing to endure hardship for the sake of Christ. Pray for ourselves that we may practice what we ask for in prayer.
